



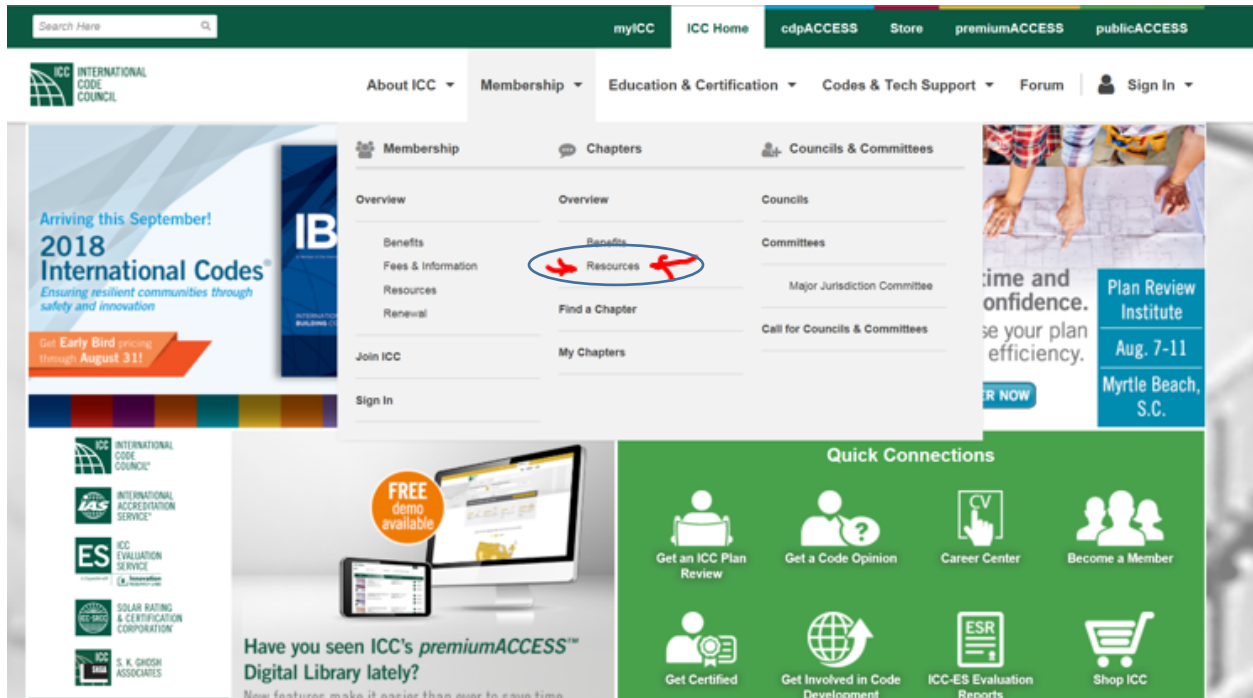
## Chapter Reward Application – Tutorial

The ICC Chapter Rewards program is a way for active chapters to earn additional chapter benefits, including complimentary registration to the Annual Business Meeting, credit to assist in purchasing ICC training, and certificates for purchase of ICC products and services.

Region I encourages all member chapters to apply for Chapter Rewards, as the benefits can be significant, and serve to reward your chapter for all of the work you already are doing.

To access the Chapter Reward Application, first open the International Code Council website [www.iccsafe.org](http://www.iccsafe.org)

Hover the mouse over “Membership” to activate the drop-down options. Underneath “Chapters”, under “Overview”, click on “Resources”

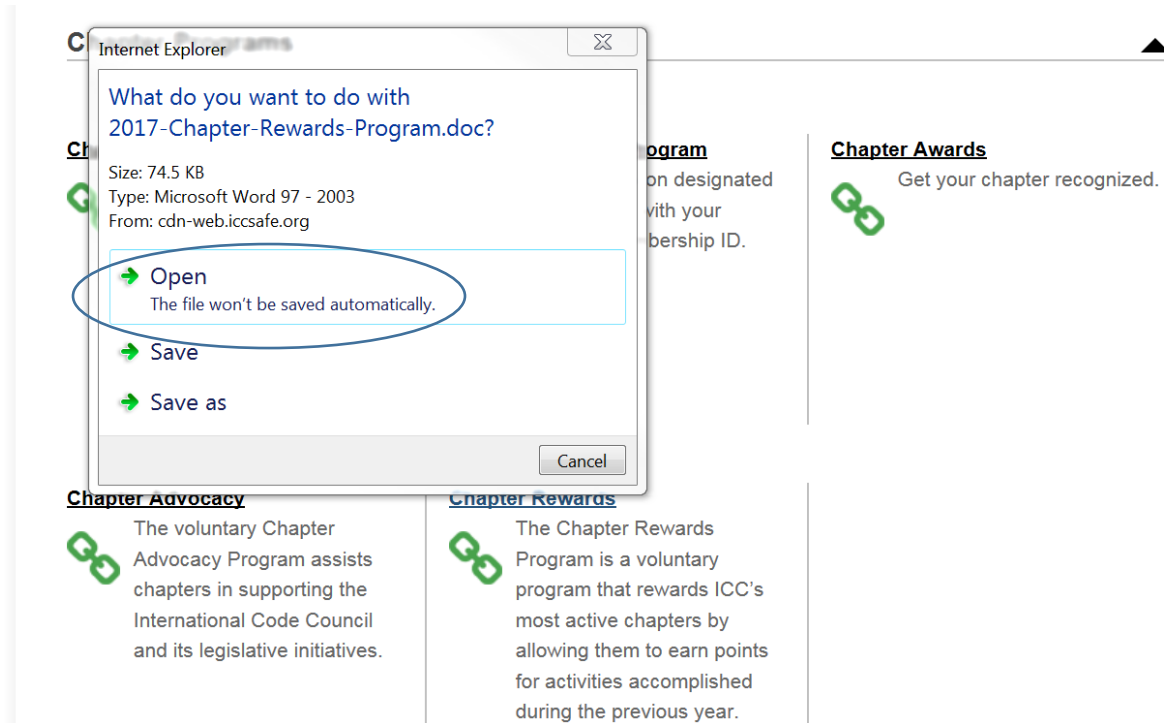


A new page appears with the title “Chapter Resources” prominently displayed. Scroll down the page to the “Chapter Programs” section to find and click on “Chapter Rewards”

### Chapter Programs

<b>Chapter Education Benefit</b> The Chapter Education Benefit provides Chapters with an education voucher good for either one-day of training through an ICC Preferred Provider or one day of ICC training.	<b>Chapter Discount Program</b> Get discounts on designated ICC products with your chapter's membership ID.	<b>Chapter Awards</b> Get your chapter recognized.
<b>Chapter Advocacy</b> The voluntary Chapter Advocacy Program assists chapters in supporting the International Code Council and its legislative initiatives.	<b>Chapter Rewards</b> The Chapter Rewards Program is a voluntary program that rewards ICC's most active chapters by allowing them to earn points for activities accomplished during the previous year.	

A pop-up window appears to select how to download the document. If you are ready to fill out the application, select "Open". If you need to save the document for later, select either "Save" or "Save as" per your preference.



When you open the document, it will open in Microsoft Word. The application explains the program and the process for applying. The program uses a three-year time frame, in that the application is submitted in 2017, but the chapter activities need to be from 2016, and any benefits awarded are used in 2018. Please be sure to report chapter activities from 2016.
